## TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 2014

## FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF

## A TWO HUNDRED FOOT "NO-WAKE" ZONE ON OTSEGO LAKE

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the conservation and preservation of Otsego Lake that motorboats be restricted from within two hundred feet of the shoreline; and WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the citizens of the Town of Springfield to encourage such conservation and preservation;

THEREFORE, be it enacted:

**THAT** no vessel shall be operated within two hundred feet of the shore, dock, pier, raft, float, or an anchored or moored vessel at a speed exceeding five miles per hour, unless such vessel is being operated near such shore, dock, float, pier or anchored vessel for the purpose of enabling a person engaged in water skiing to take off or land;

**THAT** this regulation shall apply to so much of the shore line of Otsego Lake which constitutes the Town of Springfield;

**THAT** a violation of this section of the rules and regulations authorized herein shall constitute an offense punishable by fine not to exceed \$50.00.
